Evolution of YTP

Originally a college and career readiness platform designed to serve 5,000 Emirati youth, YTP has evolved into a transferrable skills program with 42,000+ users.

As a supplemental tool, stakeholders can integrate YTP into their operations.

- Universities gain access to a tool that supports faculty and staff in delivering employability-related skills, freeing up time and resources.
- Employers can implement professional and transferable skill development courses into their operations, building a more skilled workforce.

Scaling the Impact

UAE - AGFE and Zayed University have collaborated to implement YTP across university programs over 1,000 students and trained over 700 faculty.

Region - Luminus Technical University College in Jordan has integrated YTP into their programs with over 4,900 students registered and engaged on the platform.




Overview
