What is NOMU?

Spearheaded by AGFE, NOMU is a multi-sector initiative that aims to boost the competitiveness of Emirati youth.

NOMU, Arabic for "growth," will serve as a scalable model which recognizes, equips, and supports youth as critical actors in the sustainable development of the UAE.

Alignment with SDGs 4, 8, and 17

Supports education systems that encourage youth's participation in sustainable development.

Responds to a call for inclusive and equitable quality education (SDG 4) that leads to improved standards of living (SDG 8), through partnerships (SDG 17).

Allied with the Global Councils on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGsGC) for this Decade in Action to lead impact-driven projects around the world.

Why NOMU?

- 28% of the workforce in the UAE needs reskilling and upskilling (KPMG, 2021).
- **84%** of UAE companies plan to hire new employees with new digital skills (WEF, 2020).
- 30% of university graduates in the UAE lack the digital skills required for business (WEF, 2020).
- Closing the skills gap might result in an additional 43,000 jobs and \$4.3 billion in GDP by 2030 in the UAE (WEF & PwC, 2021).

What is the goal?

To upskill and reskill 25,000 Emirati youth by 2025 and equip them with the skills, tools, and experience they need to succeed in a digital, knowledge-based economy.
